

Are you interested in helping to grow and develop the Youth Work workforce in Wales?

Do you already have a Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement Level 3 or equivalent?

Welsh Government is funding **6 places** for professionally qualified Youth Workers to train as Assessors and Internal Quality Assurers (IQAs) in Wales by undertaking the: **Award in Internal Quality Assurance of Assessment Processes and Practice, Level 4**. This is a 1 year part-time programme, which will qualify you to understand and carry out assessment and internal quality assurance for Youth Support Worker qualifications and related accredited training.

Course Content (Jan 2024 – Dec 2024):

Taught sessions: 4 x 1 day, 1 x half day, Monday 10am – 1pm: 15.01.24, 22.01.24, 29.01.24, 05.02.24.

Produce evidence portfolio and be able to work with at least 2 assessors who are each assessing a minimum of 2 learners working towards the achievement of a vocational qualification.

Entry requirements for this funded training:

Learners must be 18 years of age or over to undertake the qualifications.

Qualified Tutor Assessor with Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement Level 3, or equivalent.

Further requirements for this funded training for Youth Workers in Wales:

Professionally qualified (or working towards) and practicing Youth Worker (Level 5 pre-2010/ Level 6 post-2010/Level 7 PGDip)
